




RESEARCH QUESTIONS




FINDINGS:



Communication between Grade Levels & Schools

"I THINK SOMETHING THAT WOULD BE MORE HELPFUL MAYBE WOULD BE LIKE US OBSERVING EACH OTHER'S CLASSROOMS LIKE SINCE [OTHER TEACHER] HAS LIKE USED IT BEFORE LIKE MAYBE WE GO OBSERVE A LESSON IN [THEIR CLASS] EACH DAY OR LIKE JUST SEEING IT IN PRACTICE IN OTHER CLASSROOMS THAT WOULD BE HELPFUL OR HELPFUL"





FINDINGS:

More Involvement with Administration



"NO ONE IS BREATHING DOWN MY KNECK...
THEY ARE SUPPORTIVE BUT FROM AFAR."

"UM THERE'S A THERE'S DEFINITELY A TRUST IS REQUIRED ON BOTH ENDS. THEY NEED TO BE ABLE TO TRUST ME AND I NEED TO BE ABLE TO TRUST THEM. AND THAT OPEN COMMUNICATION IN ORDER TO MAKE SURE THAT THINGS HAPPEN."

"WRESTLING WITH DILEMMA OF HOW TO MAKE PROGRAMMING AS RELEVANT AND POSSIBLE FOR STUDENTS", WHICH MEANS AS TEACHERS WEWOULD BASICALLY HAVE TO HANDWRITE THE SEL CURRICULUM. BUT NO ONE HAS TIME FOR THAT."


How DEI & Multicultural Competencies Come Into Play

"CURRICULUM AND CULTURAL GO HAND IN HAND"

"... IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF [THE DEI DIRECTOR]
WOULD JUMP IN ON [SEL] CONVERSATIONS
BECAUSE LIKE WHILE I FEEL CONFIDENT LEADING
THEM, AND I THINK IT'S GOOD FOR LIKE MY
COLLEAGUES, MY OTHER TEAM LEADERS TO SEE
HOW SOMEBODY WOULD MODEL THAT KIND OF
CONVERSATION, I WOULD LOVE TO SEE HIM MODEL
THAT TYPE OF CONVERSATION BECAUSE I'M SURE
[...] LIKE HE JUST HAS A DIFFERENT IDENTITY THAN
I DO IN SOME AREAS."

"I WANT THEM TO HAVE A DIFFERENT EXPOSURE TO IT BECAUSE THEIR WORLD IS DIFFERENT FROM MINE."

- Last day of school year-what's next?






FINAL THOUGHTS

- Understanding teacher experiences and addressing the lack of schoolwide culture of SEL
- How do I move from individual/classroom-based SEL to more of a schoolwide model?
- Support from administration versus wants and needs of teachers
- How do I account for socio-cultural competencies in teachings?
- What are ways that I can increase access to SEL in Worcester?
- Is it more important that more schools have SEL or that the SEL that is in schools right now is of a high quality? (access or quality)
